Operations

- Mission, Vision and Values identified in partnership with Thrift Shop & Wellness Center teams

Customers

- Create Healthy Thrift Shop & Boutique customers grew from 27,663 in 2022 to 28,026 in 2023.
- Stevens Wellness Center members grew from 1,209 in January 2023 to 3,237 in November 2023.



Community Impact

- Hosted 70 participants for the Community Summit and identified key priorities for the community
- 14 team members served the community across 12 unique outreach programs, including:
 - Healthy living and wellness education
 - Breastfeeding education
 - First Aid, CPR, and "Stop the Bleed" training
 - Fitness facility use for police & first responders
- 200 Thanksgiving meals provided to families in need
- Create Healthy supported FHS student athletes as a Billie Booster and football game sponsor

Investments

Create Healthy's 2023 funding investments include:

- \$43,200 in event sponsorships
- \$2,112,700 in community donations, including:
 - \$75,000 toward the Texas Wine Auction's Wellness Uncorked health care initiative
 - \$1,000,000 in Childcare Investments
- \$100,000 in scholarships
- Fuel to the Fire Matching Donation Campaign -\$25,000 per organization - \$250,000 total
- 233 served from the Healthy U program
